Office of the Anti-Discrimination Commissioner is responsible for Tasmania's anti-discrimination law: the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1998 (Tas)*.

Discrimination is when someone is treated unfairly because of something they can't change like their race, disability or who they love. The *Anti-Discrimination Act* makes discrimination, and other related conduct (such as offensive conduct and sexual harassment) unlawful.

What we do

- We take complaints and reports from people who have been treated in a way that is against the *Anti-Discrimination Act*.
- We educate people about discrimination and their rights.
- We give advice about programs, policies and laws to try to make sure discrimination does not happen in Tasmania.

How can we help?

- We talk to people who have questions about the *Anti-Discrimination Act*.
- We talk to people who may want to make a complaint, or report something, and people who want to make sure they are not discriminating.
- We can help people write down their complaints. It is free to make a complaint.
- We investigate complaints.
- We help people resolve their complaints.
- We deliver training and awareness sessions about the *Anti-Discrimination Act*.
- We can provide free materials like brochures and posters about discrimination that let people know about their rights.

A team of specialised case managers work across Tasmania to provide confidential, non-judgemental support to all members of the community, regardless of their different abilities, gender, beliefs, or backgrounds.

SafeChoices is a Tasmanian government funded initiative that delivers a range of supports to individuals and families effected by family violence, including:

- Information, advice & outreach.
- Case management (referrals and links to other services)
- Early intervention, safety and exit planning.
- Post-separation support.
- Assisting with letters of support and applications for funding to help escape family violence.
- Supporting clients to report family violence to police.
- Support and care during legal appointments and court appearances.
